PANEL FINALS PROCEDURES AND RULES

- 1. Audition Length. Finals Audition Applicants for Panel Honors and Master Class have a 10-minute audition. Applicants for Young Artist Guild have a 30-minute audition, and if not selected for YAG, may be selected for Panel Honors or Master Class if eligible. See *Page B* for repertoire requirements.
- 2. Application Form & Fees. Applications submitted without all signatures will not be processed and student will not be scheduled for Finals Auditions. All Fees are non-refundable. Teacher must send only one check for the total amount of application fees of all students.
- 3. Application Submission. Complete all information on *Page A* and make THREE (3) copies. Complete all information on *Page B* and make SIX (6) copies. Please use a large manila envelope (at least 9x12) to submit all copies and one check. Teacher may make additional copies for own records.
- 4. **Rules.** Teacher must refer to the applicable *Syllabus* and *Certificate of Merit* Panel Auditions Guidelines for further information regarding Panel Rules and requirements related to repertoire, technique, sight-reading, and theory, and other rules.
- 5. **Final Decision.** The decision of the Judges is **final**. Any direct discussion regarding results by the Teacher, Student, or Parent with Judges will disqualify the student, and may jeopardize student's future Convention opportunities.
- 6. Emergency. If an emergency prevents a student from performing at Convention, the Teacher must notify the Panel Coordinator immediately:
